#### **ARTICLE2: COORDINATION**

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of AWEC, and a programme coordinator from the side of SJCET, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.
